What Is Immobilise?

- Immobilise is a secure, online property register where you can store details of your personal property (eg, phone, camera, bike, laptop, games console, etc).
- Immobilise is a **free service**, but the website does have an online shop where you can buy crime reduction products and insurance.
- · Immobilise is approved by the Home Office.
- Once you have an Immobilise account, you can add/remove property, include photos and details of sale/theft/loss.
- If your property is stolen, Immobilise will help the police, your insurer and the second-hand trade to assist in recovering your property and catching the thief.

How Does Immobilise Help The Police?

- Immobilise provides information for the National Mobile Property Register (NMPR) database.
- The police use the NMPR to identify the rightful owner of any property they recover (if they have an Immobilise account).
- The police use the NMPR to find out if the stolen property has been presented for sale at a second-hand business. They can then make enquiries as to who presented the property for sale.
- NMPR alerts Bedfordshire police if another police service has also searched for the same item of property.

Immobilise Application - Admin Notes

- Firstly, please ensure the applicant has access to the Internet and an email account.
- Please explain to each applicant that it will take a few days for their application to be processed.
- They can expect to receive an email from Immobilise to complete their account registration.
- Once they have done this, they can then add further items of property.
- You only need to complete the event details on the top-most form.
- Please ensure all forms are securely bound together, or put into an envelope, to prevent accidental separation.
